Fees for permit applications and changes

Annual permit fees

(under the Crown Minerals Act 1991)

Permit	Fee (NZ\$)
Prospecting permit	\$3.50 per sq km or part of a sq km or \$500, whichever is greater
Exploration permit	Initial term - \$3.50 per hectare or part of a hectare or \$500, whichever is greater Extension under section 37 (1) - \$8.50 per hectare or part of a hectare or \$500, whichever is greater Extension under section 37 (2) - \$8.50 per hectare or part of a hectare or \$500, whichever is greater
Mining permit	\$10 per hectare or part of a hectare or \$500, whichever is greater
