

NOTICE OF SURRENDER OR PARTIAL SURRENDER

UNDER SECTION 40,
CROWN MINERALS ACT 1991

Please complete the following:

- Crown Minerals recommends that applicants familiarise themselves with the Crown Minerals Act 1991 (the “Act”), the relevant regulations, the relevant minerals programme and seek professional advice where appropriate before submitting a notice of surrender.
- It is not necessary to submit a notice of surrender for relinquishments (i.e. the area of an exploration permit that is given up when the duration of a permit is extended under section 37(1) or (2) of the Act) or where a permit is being exchanged for a subsequent permit pursuant to section 32 of the Act.
- The personal information you must include in this form is needed to process your application under the Act. You have the right under the Privacy Act 1993 and/or the Official Information Act 1982 to access information held about you by Crown Minerals and request that this information be corrected if necessary.
- Please note, if the space on any part of this form is insufficient to include all relevant details, place them on a separate sheet, state “see attached sheet” in the appropriate space, and attach the sheet to the form.

SECTION 2

2 Surrender details

No fee is required for a notice of surrender. Surrenders take effect on the date the Secretary accepts the notice of surrender. Annual fees for permits will be recalculated from this date to account for the surrender/partial surrender and an appropriate refund will be made for any fees paid in advance.

The surrender of a permit does not release the permit holder from any liability in respect of the permit up to the date of the surrender or any act under the permit up to the date of surrender giving rise to a cause of action.

For petroleum permits, the boundaries of the area of land that is to be surrendered must be located and defined on the map by lines of latitude or longitude, if practicable to do so, or straight line edges between turning points, in any other case. For minerals and coal permits, boundaries must be located and defined on the map using 1 or more of the descriptors specified in regulation 30(3) of the Crown Minerals (Minerals and Coal) Regulations 2007.

SECTION 4

Notices of surrender must be signed by every permit holder or a person authorised to sign by the permit holder.

By signing the notice, the permit holder warrants that the information provided in the notice is true and correct. Where the permit holder is a company, partnership, society, trust or other legal entity, the notice must be signed in accordance with the relevant legislative requirements, constitution, or rules by a person or agent with the requisite authority.

Where the notice is signed by an agent, or on behalf of a permit holder, a copy of the requisite authorisation must be included with the notice.
